At the Glazer Children's Museum

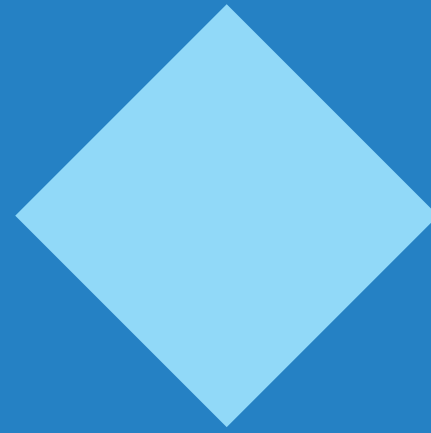

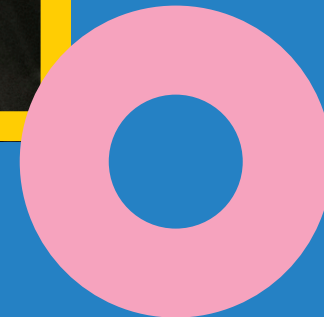

other campers share.





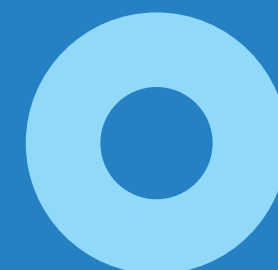

schedule.



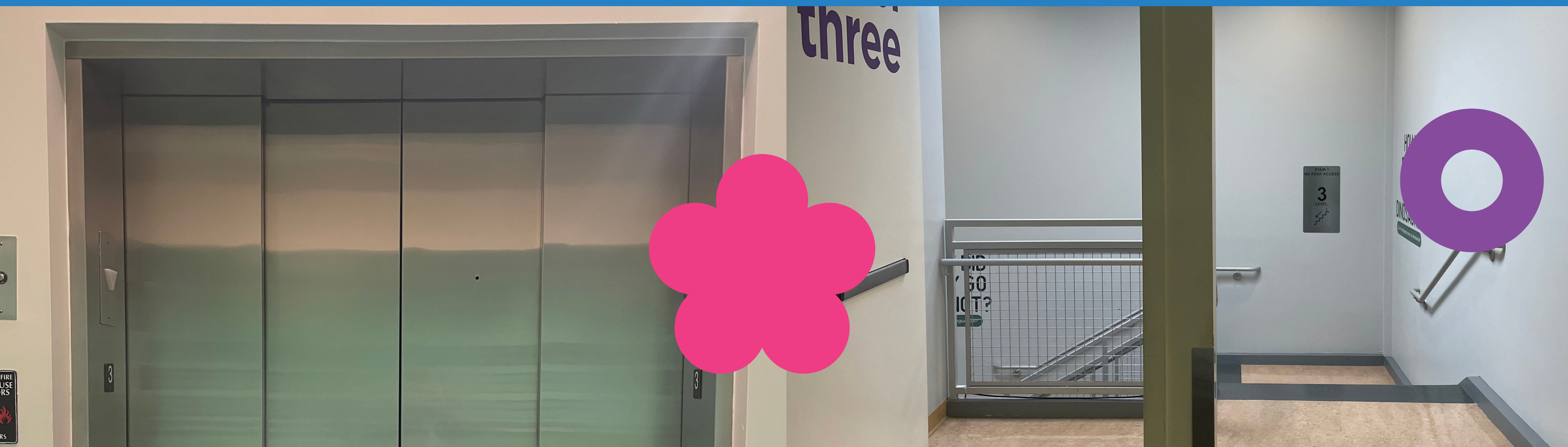


At the Glazer Children's Museum

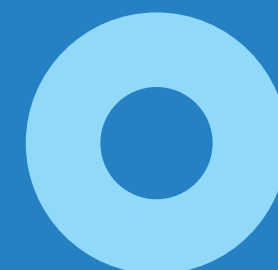


At the Glazer Children's Museum

It is time for afternoon snack. If I need help opening a container or package, I will raise my hand and my teacher will help me.

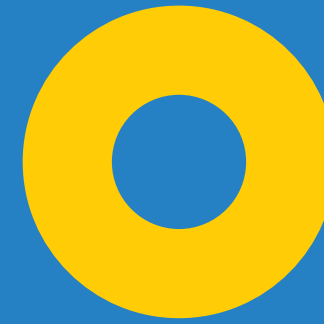
I will not share food with other campers.

At the end of the day, my teacher will ask us to clean up. I will throw my trash away and put all of my supplies where they belong. Then, I will line up with my class.





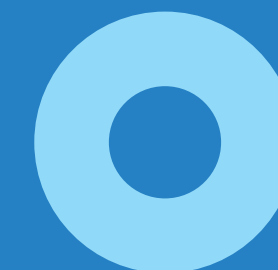
At the Glazer Children's Museum
